## **General Info**

- Parking is available under the Aotea Centre in the Civic carpark
- There will be 32 teams of 4 players competing
- 2 Teams will be randomly selected to play at each board. Boards are numbered 1 -16
- Each team will play a series of round robin games against the other team. All games during round robin will be played at your designated board so you can make yourself comfortable!
- Winning teams from the Round Robin play will go through to the Main Finals Series & losing teams will compete in the Consolation Finals Series
- All final series matches will be 1 leg of 501 Team of 4 VS Team of 4. No pairs or singles
- The finals series is a knockout format. If you lose your finals match, you are out!
- Feel free to bring your own darts otherwise darts will be supplied for you, alternatively Shot Darts will have a stand set up on the day that you are welcome to purchase from.








## **Match Rules**

- Each match will be one leg of 501 or 701 for finals.
- Matches start at the score of 501/701 & countdown
- The winner is the player/team who reaches the score of zero first.
- You must score zero not go past zero. I.e If you have 5 left, you must score 5.
- We are playing a social format therefore you do not have to double out to finish/win the match.



- Double outs will be played in the Grand finals of the finals series for both the top 8 & bottom 8 divisions.
- To start each match, each player throws at the bullseye. Closest to the bullseye starts the match.
